Supplied in: 50 mM NaCl, 10 mM Tris-HCl (pH 7.4), 0.1 mM EDTA, 1 mM DTT, 200  $\mu g/ml$  BSA and 50% glycerol.

**Reagents Supplied with Enzyme:** 10X NEBuffer 4. 100X BSA.

Reaction Conditions: 1X NEBuffer 4, supplemented with 100 µg/ml BSA. Incubate at 60°C.

#### 1X NEBuffer 4:

50 mM potassium acetate 20 mM Tris-acetate 10 mM magnesium acetate 1 mM dithiothreitol pH 7.9 @ 25°C

Unit Definition: One unit is defined as the amount of enzyme required to digest 1  $\mu g$  of  $\lambda$  DNA in 1 hour at 60°C in a total reaction volume of 50  $\mu$ l.

**Diluent Compatibility:** Diluent Buffer A 50 mM KCl, 10 mM Tris-HCl, 0.1 mM EDTA, 1 mM DTT, 200  $\mu$ g/ml BSA and 50% glycerol (pH 7.4 @ 25°C).

### **Quality Control Assays**

**Ligation:** After 10-fold overdigestion with BsaWI, > 95% of the DNA fragments can be ligated with T4 DNA Ligase (at a 5´ termini concentration of  $1-2~\mu$ M) at  $16^{\circ}$ C. Of these ligated fragments, > 95% can be recut.

**16-Hour Incubation:** A 50 µl reaction containing 1 µg of DNA and 50 units of enzyme incubated for 16 hours resulted in the same pattern of DNA bands as a reaction incubated for 1 hour with 1 unit of enzyme.

**Exonuclease Activity:** Incubation of 50 units of enzyme with 1  $\mu$ g sonicated <sup>3</sup>H DNA (10<sup>5</sup> cpm/ $\mu$ g) for 4 hours at 60°C in 50  $\mu$ l reaction buffer released < 0.1% radioactivity.

### **Enzyme Properties**

### **Activity in NEBuffers:**

NEBuffer 1 50% NEBuffer 2 100% NEBuffer 3 50% NEBuffer 4 **100**%

When using a buffer other than the optimal (supplied) NEBuffer, it may be necessary to add more enzyme to achieve complete digestion.

**Survival in a Reaction:** Suitable for an extended or overnight digestion. Enzyme is active > 8 hours.

**Heat Inactivation:** 80°C for 20 minutes.

Note: BsaWI is an isoschizomer of Betl.

Not sensitive to *dam, dcm* or mammalian CpG methylation.

Incubation at 37°C results in 20% activity.
