## Purified anti-mouse CD155 (PVR)

**Immunogen:** EL4 transfected with mouse CD155

**Preparation:** The antibody was purified by affinity chromatography.

**Formulation:** Phosphate-buffered solution, pH 7.2, containing 0.09% sodium azide.

**Concentration:** 0.5 mg/ml

**Storage:** The antibody solution should be stored undiluted at 4°C.

**Recommended Usage:** Each lot of this antibody is quality control tested by immunofluorescent staining with flow cytometric analysis. For immunofluorescent staining, the suggested use of this reagent is  $\leq 0.25$  µg per  $10^6$  cells in 100 µl volume. It is recommended that the reagent be titrated for optimal performance for each application.

**Description:** Mouse CD155, also known as homolog of poliovirus receptor, is the founding member of a subfamily of immunoglobulin-like adhesion receptors (nectins). Mouse CD155 is expressed on a wide variety of cells of hematopoietic origin apart from its existence on the epithelial cells. The engagement of CD155 with CD226 and CD96 induces cytotoxicity of NK cells and CTL.
