

# Anti-Mouse CD1d Functional Grade Purified

# Description

The 1B1 monoclonal antibody reacts with mouse CD1d, a 48 kDa glycoprotein with structural homology to MHC class I molecules. While similar to MHC Class I, CD1d associates with  $\beta$ 2-m, functionally CD1d is similar to MHC Class II. 1B1 detects CD1d at varying levels on mouse leukocytes. 1B1 detects  $\beta$ 2-m associated CD1d.

#### **Applications Reported**

The 1B1 antibody has been reported for use in flow cytometric analysis. 1B1 has also been reported in *in vivo* and *in vitro* studies.

#### **Applications Tested**

The 1B1 antibody has been tested by flow cytometeric analysis of mouse splenocyte suspensions. This can be used at less than or equal to 1  $\mu$ g per test. A test is defined as the amount ( $\mu$ g) of antibody that will stain a cell sample in a final volume of 100  $\mu$ L. Cell number should be determined empirically but can range from 10<sup>5</sup> to 10<sup>8</sup> cells/test. It is recommended that the antibody be carefully titrated for optimal performance in the assay of interest.
