

Storage Buffer: Aqueous buffered solution containing BSA and ≤0.09% sodium azide.

### Description

Reacts with the major 95-135 kDa sialoglycoprotein found on most human leukocytes and identical to the molecules called sialophorin or leukosialin. CD43 antigen is expressed on T cells, NK cells and granulocytes, but is not present on most peripheral blood B cells, RBCs, platelets and non-hematopoietic cells. CD43 may be involved in the regulations of B, T and NK cell function. This antibody is suitable for staining formalin-fixed, paraffin-embedded tissue sections with TUF pretreatment.

This antibody is routinely tested by flow cytometric analysis. Other applications were tested at BD Biosciences Pharmingen during antibody development only or reported in the literature.

### **Preparation and Storage**

The monoclonal antibody was purified from tissue culture supernatant or ascites by affinity chromatography. The antibody was conjugated with FITC under optimum conditions, and unreacted FITC was removed. Store undiluted at 4° C and protected from prolonged exposure to light. Do not freeze.
